trucks are disproportionately represented in fatal accidents and it is generally the occupants of the smaller, lighter vehicles that come off worst in collisions between cars and trucks. The deaths or serious injuries of occupants of smaller vehicles are often caused by the driver of the smaller vehicle not responding in time to avoid the collision, largely due to poor visibility - they simply didn't see the truck in time to avoid a collision.



- In 61% of fatal crashes, the truck driver was identified as not being at fault.
- Around 80% of truck crash fatalities occur on the open road, with 42% occurring at night.

WHAT ARE REFLECTIVE TAPES & VINYLS?



Goodman Fielder truck with red conspicuity tape outline. As you can see, it has minimal impact on your vehicle's daytime aesthetic, however it will have a huge impact on your vehicle's visibility at night.


Reflective vinyls or films and tapes are composed of wide angle, exposed retroflective lenses bonded to an adhesive. They help the eye perceive objects in low-light conditions when illuminated by a light source (ie the lights from a vehicle).







Reflective vinyl and retroreflective tape contour markings (also known as 'conspicuity tape') on a heavy vehicle are designed to give other road users visibility of the vehicle ahead and the ability to perceive their distance and closing distance. A full contour of the vehicle makes this visible perception easiest. A contour means that the outline shape of the vehicle is depicted as clearly as possible.

Studies have proven the usage of reflective tape/vinyl on trucks is effective in increasing visibility, particularly at night and in poor visibility conditions such as rain, fog, dusk and dawn where light is poor. Earlier visibility leaves more response time for the driver, enhancing safety.

Significant reductions in side and rear impacts can be achieved with the use of reflective tapes:

41% decrease in rear end collisions 37% decrease in side collisions


INCREASED TRUCK VISIBILITY COSTS LESS THAN \$2.50 A WEEK

The application cost of retroreflective markings is low and Admark's 3M products are warrantied for a period of up to seven years. A full contour marking for an average tanker costs around \$900; divide this by 7 for the annual cost and by 52 for the weekly cost. At just under \$2.50 a week, the numbers stack up. But let's face it - it's not really about numbers is it? It's about people's lives.

Interestingly, studies have estimated the cost per truck incident at more than \$120,000AUD. They also showed that fatalities were not the fault of the truck driver. Further, at least 70% of truck crashes involved a truck and another vehicle and 40% of road accidents occurred at night due to only 5% of the information on a heavy vehicle being seen. They concluded a continuous reflective strip is most effective and maintains 50-70% effectiveness in adverse weather vs no markings.

PREFERRED LAYOUT - FULL CONTOUR



Reflective tape is applied as close as possible to the edge of the vehicle to form a continuous line, depicting the outline of the vehicle. This provides maximum visibility to other road users and is best practice.

ESTIMATED COST: \$650-900

Outlining the front, rear and sides of your vehicle with retroreflective material significantly improves its visibility. This material reflects other motorist's lights back off your vehicle. Reflective conspicuity tape is effective and quick and easy to apply.


PARTIAL CONTOUR



partial contour marking

A single strip of retroreflective tape is applied along each side and the rear of the body or trailer, with 'L' shape sections 0.5m long in each corner. ESTIMATED COST: \$600

STRIP MARKING



Strip markings of yellow or white on the sides

A single strip of retroreflective tape is applied along each side of the vehicle and body or trailer side, and a strip across the rear. This basic layout shall only apply to those vehicles that do not use retroreflective graphics or logos or have limited structure onto which tape can be applied on the upper sections of the trailer.

ESTIMATED COST: \$750

FRONT OF TRAILERS



It is highly recommended that if a trailer or truck is regularly parked outside a secured depot, retroreflective tape should be applied to its forward face.

ESTIMATED COST: \$290-450

CURTAIN SIDERS



Example of segmented tape options for curtain sided trailers

Due to the materials used on curtain-side trailers, special retroreflective tapes must be used - they are either flexible or segmented so they can flex as the curtain is retracted. Colours should be yellow, white or silver. The placement of strips should follow one of the options detailed previously.

ESTIMATED COST: \$900

PRICING NOTES

Pricing is indicative only and may vary from application to application, dependent on a number of factors. Pricing is current as at November 2016. Retroreflective tape to suit either curved or flexible surfaces (ie truck curtains) will cost around 50% more than standard tape applicable to hard, flat surfaces. Application is dependent on access to the top of the trailer. The availability of suitable equipment for working at heights to apply the material will have significant impact on the tape's application time.

Preparation with isopropyl alcohol, dirt free etc = \$20 per 15 minute unit.

Approved standards markings in New Zealand:


Yellow or white/silver tape on sides | yellow or white/silver tape on front | red or alternating red and white/silver tape on rear. When used around lamps, the tape should be the same colour as the lamps.

Many rubbish trucks will not be able to take a full line or contour marking due to the equipment being fitted. In these cases, it is acceptable to retain rear marker plates with conspicuity markings fitted to the fullest extent practicable.
